While we hope nothing ever happens to our active employees, we want make you aware of this benefit so that you can make wise decisions for your family. Bags should be placed in appropriate cleaning bins, and FS coats should be left with your supervisor or dropped off at Jim Tolbert's desk. If pieces are missing, the cost of the missing pieces can be deducted from your last paycheck.
